



Coyote Creek Trail (Story Ave-Phelan Ave)



About 3 miles on the way

- 0.96 mile (William-Story)
- 0.87 mile (Story-Phelan)
- 1.39 mile (Phelan-Tully)



Trail Safety Plan

- Goal: Public safety & sense of security
- Approach: Trail Safety Plan
 - Address complex social issue
 - Supplement SJPD with well-aligned partners
- Funding: Leverage and seek additional resources
 - Annual budget, maintenance (\$17,050/mile)
 - Annual Budget, seek supplemental funding
 - AHSC Grant funds trail safety program (\$300,000+)
