

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE RATIFYING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH AT&T PROVIDING CONNECTIVITY TO RESIDENTS IMPACTED BY COVID-19 THAT EXTENDS THE CONTRACT TERM TO SEPTEMBER 1, 2021 AND INCREASES THE MAXIMUM COMPENSATION FROM \$3,430,000 TO \$5,116,000

WHEREAS, the City of San José (“City”) has allocated significant resources and focus to the COVID-19 pandemic response, including helping our most vulnerable populations and ensuring the continuity of City services, since the County of Santa Clara shelter-in-place orders first took effect on March 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, one of the City’s response areas provides broadband internet access for families affected by COVID-19 who are unable to access the internet; and

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2020, the City Council authorized the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement with AT&T for the provision of 11,000 Wi-Fi hotspots with a one-year data plan; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Clara County Office of Education and San José school districts have identified an additional need of 4,800 hotspots to assist with remote learning; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the additional 4,800 hotspots is approximately \$1.7 million; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with San José Municipal Code 4.12.220 - Emergency purchases, the City Manager took action to execute an amended agreement with AT&T to respond to the urgent need created by the pandemic by providing additional hotspots for distance learning during the academic school year that had already commenced; and

WHEREAS, staff estimates that the hotspots will be configured and delivered by the first week of October;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The amendment to the Agreement with AT&T providing connectivity to residents impacted by COVID-19 that extends the contract term to September 1, 2021 and increases the maximum compensation from \$3,430,000 to \$5,116,000 is hereby ratified.
