SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF NATIONAL NIGHT OUT AS A CITY SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENT, TO EXPEND CITY FUNDS AND AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT DONATIONS OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE EVENT

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve the National Night Out scheduled for October 6, 2020 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the October 6, 2020 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds in Special Event Accounts.

National Night Out is a free city event, open to the public, and held annually on the first Tuesday of every August, with this year's rescheduled to October 6, 2020, the first Tuesday in October, due to COVID-19. The events, held at various locations throughout the City, are coordinated through many Council Offices with the assistance of the San Jose Police Department and other City Departments. This is a national effort held in collaboration with a wide variety of individuals, neighborhood and business associations, community-based organizations, schools, and community volunteers.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the Rules and Open Government Committee and City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. compliance with existing fundraising disclosure requirements, all participating Council Offices will report any solicitations made and donations received for the event in the Councilmembers' Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
