The recommendation to explore, analyze, and report back to City Council on an option to exempt medical marijuana identification card (MMIC) holders from paying the City's Cannabis Business Tax (CBT) is advised to follow the Priority Setting Process for the following reasons:

- 1) The analysis to determine the budgetary impact will require the collection and review of large amounts of data from the Cannabis businesses. The analysis will also require a sensitivity analysis of various inputs to determine the potential impact.
- 2) The County's Health Advisory Commission is evaluating a recommendation to eliminate or reduce the MMIC processing fee. Changes to the MMIC fee would impact the analysis on the City's CBT and sales tax revenue. Analysis should only proceed after the County has made a determination on the amount of the MMIC fee.
- 3) The business unit responsible for overseeing this program for the City is at capacity with other high priority work plan assignments.
