SUBJECT: LA RAZA HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF SANTA CLARA VALLEY'S GRANT APPLICATION FOR CHIECHI HOUSE RESTORATION PROJECT

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a resolution approving La Raza Historical Society of Santa Clara Valley's application to the County of Santa Clara's Historical Grant Program for the restoration project at the Chiechi House in History Park.

BASIS FOR RECOMMENDATION:

La Raza Historical Society of Santa Clara Valley is seeking funding from the County of Santa Clara's Historical Grant program to support repairs and restoration of the Chiechi House in History Park. Some examples of the proposed repairs and restoration work included in the proposal are bathroom, flooring, staircase and ceiling repairs, bathroom renovation, and insulation. The County grant application requires a City Council resolution in support of the project. The resolution is to confirm City ownership of the site, that the City does not have current intentions to change the use of the property, that the City will issue permits in compliance with City requirements, and that the City will review and approve any necessary permits for the property in the restoration of Chiechi House. Staff is recommending that the Council approve this resolution.

Commission Recommendation/Input: No commission recommendation or input is associated with this action.
