SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF IRCC – VIET MUSEUM'S GRANT APPLICATION FOR A RESTORATION PROJECT OF GREENEWALT HOUSE AT HISTORY PARK SAN JOSE

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a resolution approving IRCC – Viet Museum's application to the County of Santa Clara's Historical Heritage Grant Program for the restoration project of Greenewalt House at History Park San Jose.

BASIS FOR RECOMMENDATION:

IRCC – Viet Museum, in partnership with History San Jose, is seeking funding from the County of Santa Clara's Historical Heritage Grant Program to support repairs and restoration of the Greenewalt House in History Park. Some examples of the proposed repairs and restoration work included in the proposal are waterproofing, insulation, window replacement, ADA ramp, and lighting repairs. The County grant application requires a City Council resolution in support of the project. The resolution is to confirm City ownership of the site, that the City does not have current intentions to change the use of the property, that the City will issue permits in compliance with City requirements, and that the City will review and approve any necessary permits for the property in the restoration of the Greenewalt House. Staff is recommending that the Council approve this resolution.

Climate Smart San Jose: The recommendation in this memo has no effect on Climate Smart San José energy, water, or mobility goals.

Commission Recommendation/Input: No commission recommendation or input is associated with this action.

COST AND FUNDING SOURCE:

No funding is needed for this project as any grant funding provided will be provided directly to IRCC – Viet Museum. IRCC – Viet Museum will oversee all project implementation costs.
