
City's State Advocacy Highlights

COVID-19 Response and Mitigation

- \$58.8 million in State funding, mainly for housing programs
 - \$44.1 million from HHAP, SB 2, SB 89
 - \$12.7 million in Project Homekey funds
 - \$2 million in Housing Authority Litigation Awards
- Legislation and Executive Orders
 - Residential and Commercial Rental Relief and Eviction Moratoriums
 - Economic Recovery and Small Business Support
 - Additional funding through small business tax credits, digital inclusion

- COVID-19
 - Coronavirus Relief Fund
- Transportation Re-authorization
 - Vision Zero
 - Sustainability/Resiliency Funding

City's Federal Advocacy Highlights
