






### Existing Conditions











#### Project Description





#### CEQA

- Little Portugal Gateway Mixed-Use Project: Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for project
- Less than significant impacts with incorporation of Mitigation Measures outlined in Mitigation and Monitoring Reporting Program (MMRP)
- Air Quality, Biological Resources, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, and Noise mitigation measures were identified and incorporated into the project to lessen the environmental impacts to less than significant levels



#### Community Outreach

- Three community meetings
  - 1) May 5, 2019
  - 2) September 23, 2019
  - 3) November 18, 2019 community preferences on design and amenities
- Major Concerns: building height, off-street parking, installation of street trees, on-site affordable housing, and displacement of residents and commercial tenants



#### Planning Commission Recommendation

October 28, 2020, Planning Commission voted to recommend City Council:

- Adopt a Resolution adopting the Little Portugal Gateway Mixed-Use Project Mitigated Negative Declaration and related MMRP; and
- 2. Approve the Rezoning Ordinance; and
- Adopt a Resolution approving the Planned Development Permit, subject to conditions
