## Background

- September 20, 2017 Rules and Open Government Committee
- City Council Policy Priority Setting Sessions
  - October 17, 2017 Rank #22
  - > March 5, 2019 Rank #23
  - February 25, 2020 Rank #18
- Santa Clara County Public Health Department (PHD) Healthy Cities Program Grant Funding
  - October 26, 2018: Submitted Application
  - November 5, 2018: Notification of Award
  - \$65,000 with In-kind County Policy Consultant support
  - Contract Term: February 2, 2020 to June 30, 2021
- Chapter 9.44 Regulation of Smoking (SJMC)
  - Prohibits smoking in publicly accessible and common areas (enclosed or unenclosed) of Multifamily Housing (MF); does not currently prohibit smoking inside units






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## Community Outreach: Survey Results
