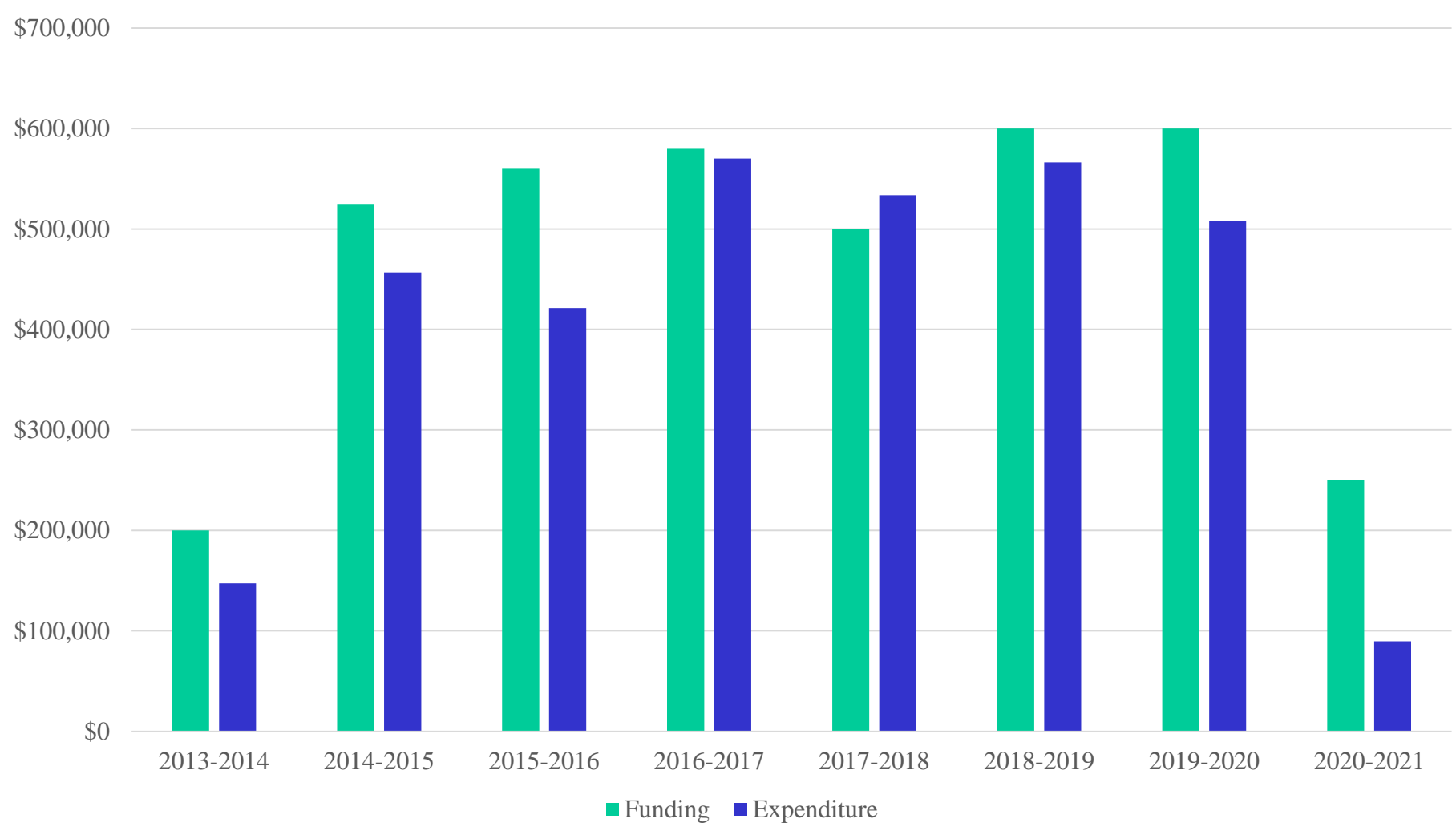

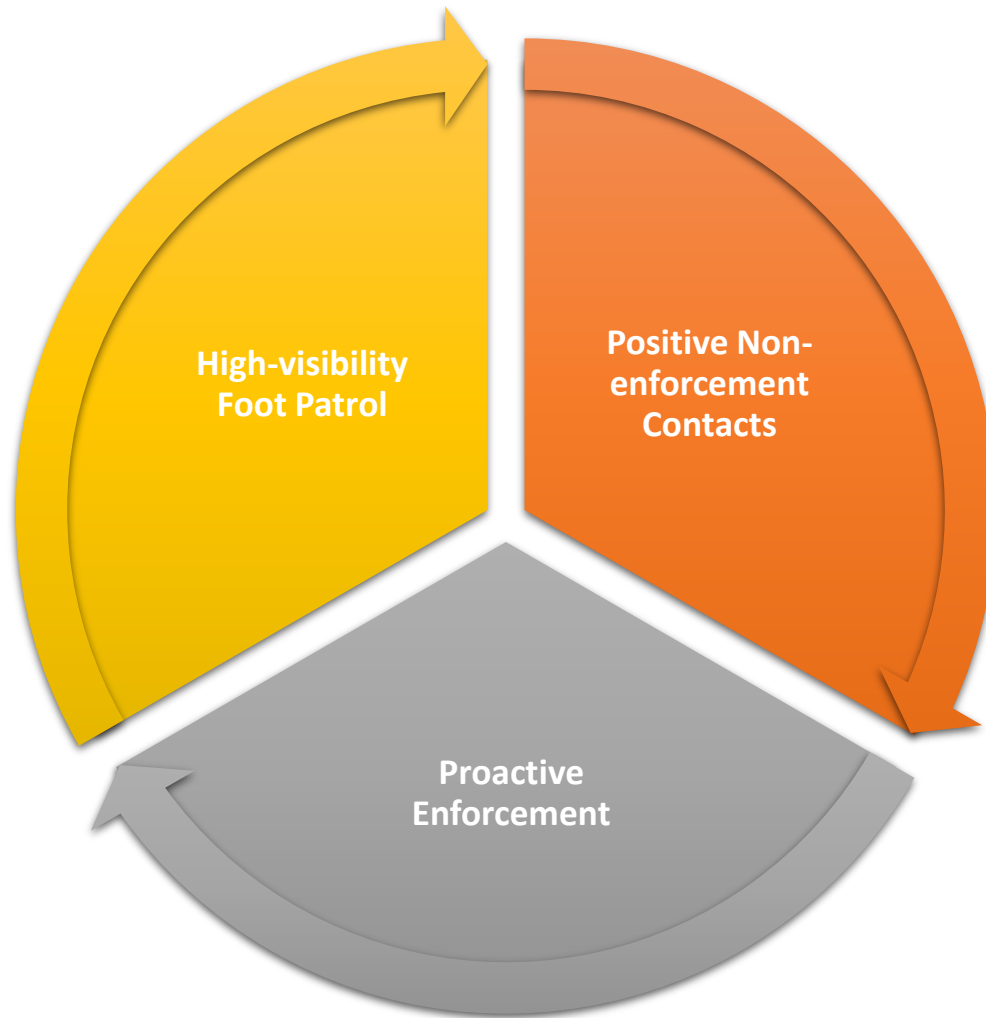

# High Need Neighborhood Foot Patrols

## Identifying High Need Neighborhoods

Location of patrols is determined by several factors, including call volume, crime rates, gang activity, community input and divisional goals.

## Implementing Patrols

High Need Neighborhood Patrols have been conducted in Western, Southern and Foothill divisions. Central Division is currently working to identify potential locations for High Needs Neighborhood patrols.

## Budget Status

Of the \$750,000 allocated for this program in the 2020-2021 Adopted Operating Budget, \$168,001 had been spent through October 31, 2020.
