## **Police Activities League**

- PAL is a nonprofit 501(c)3 providing youth athletic programs that promote constructive relationships between law enforcement and the community
- PAL utilizes the J.R. Blackmore Police Activities League Stadium Complex



# Timeline

## 2018 and 2019

- City Auditor's Office review and report
- Community outreach and engagement
- PAL, SJPD and PRNS roles change



## 2020

- PRNS presents operational models to NSE
- PRNS has partnership discussions with SJPD and PAL
- Parks Division reorganizes for focused sports complex management





## **Operating Model:**

- PAL as program operator, fundraiser, and community connector
- PRNS as contract manager and staff support for PAL board development
- SJPD as supporter with officers at programs and events
- PRNS and SJPD to have seats on PAL board of directors

## **Key Guiding Principles:**

- 3-year initial term, with two optional 3-year renewals
- In the first year of the contract, PAL will be expected to develop a strategic plan
- \$50,000 funding for PAL board and organizational development
