REPORTS TO COMMITTEE

(1) Community Energy Programs Roadmap Update. (Community Energy)

Community Energy Director Lori Mitchell, Account Management and Marketing Deputy Director Zach Struyk, and FUSE Executive Advisor and Programs Lead Kevin Meehan, gave a presentation and responded to questions.
