



# **Childcare Partners – Santa Clara County Office of Education**

- Expansion of Head Start
   programming from half-day to full-day
  - 249 in-person enrollments across
     27 zip codes in San José
  - 91 home-school connections
- 340 Calming Kits supplied to families
- Services extended into 2021
- Total contract amount: \$1,390,000



# Childcare Partners — First 5




- Provides \$10,000 grants to small, family day care providers who have been impacted by the pandemic
- 351 grants across 26 zip codes in San José
- 2,267 children have been served
- Total CRF contract amount: \$3,760,000

## R.O.C.K. 'n' Learn

- 2 program options Full day and afterschool model
- 19 unique locations community centers, libraries, and parks
- Supported by over 250 full-time and part-time staff
- Current enrollment of 413 youth, 5-14 years of age, across 37 cohorts
- Program is free to any scholarship-eligible family
- Afterschool program model available with a scholarship or for a fee

#### **Overview**

- 3 program options
- 10 unique locations at community centers and parks
- Approx. 40 full-time and part-time staff support SJRP
- Scholarship-eligible families can enroll in the program at 100% Scholarship
- Early Education Quality Standards: PRNS staff are continuing assessing each SJRP model to ensure adherence to Early Education Quality Standards and State, County and local health and safety guidelines



## **Virtual Programs**

- Virtual classes meet Monday, Wednesday, Friday for 45 minutes, with varying program hours by location.
  - Currently 96 children enrolled
- Small Group Virtual Program added in January.
  - Additional class for students enrolled in virtual program
  - Supplement learning and provide additional support for basic concepts
  - Currently 15 children enrolled

#### **In-Person Program Challenges**

Adapting facilities and program to meet Guidelines.

Staff Retention.

• Families have expressed concerned about returning to in-person programming.

Challenging to provide in-person classroom SEEDS coaching.

#### **Virtual Program Challenges**

- Participants and staff having access to technology, high speed internet in particular.
- Modifying program model to meet Early Ed Quality
   Standards in new platform (virtual).
- Virtual program has a shorter duration than a regular SJRP class, teachers must be selective in what they share.
- Challenging to provide students with fine motor skill development (i.e.: sign-in, scissors), and additional resources and support to assist with learning.







### How are we faring?


**Number of Parents Surveyed: 101** 


Grade levels: K to 8th grade












#### How would you rate the public health safety measures taken by R.O.C.K. 'n' Learn?
