




#### FirstNet - Uplift

### FirstNet Priority and Preemption Levels

Police/Fire/OEM day to day operations Level 2, 3, and 4.

Police/Fire/OEM - Manually Uplift users cellphone and or modem to higher level.

Prior to the Presidential Inauguration – Police and Fire were Uplifted to Level 1.




