# **RECOMMENDATION**

- 1. Approve the Cesar Chavez Day lighting (March 30 April 5, 2021) and proclamation event scheduled on Tuesday, March 30, 2021 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses, or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the March 30, 2020 Council Agenda for action.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

The Cesar Chavez Day lighting and proclamation will be held on Tuesday, March 30, 2021 at City Hall and will be sponsored by Councilmember Raul Peralez. The City Hall Tower and Rotunda will be lit in red starting on March 30 through April 5, 2021 in observance of Cesar Chavez Day. Cesar Chavez Day will aim to remember all the contributions Cesar Chavez led in an effort to obtain better working conditions, improve pay and offer support to the

thousands of farm workers who tirelessly labored in the fields. It is also an opportunity to celebrate his legacy and all the work that still continues. The event is free and open to the public but due to the current shelter in place and limits on public gatherings, there will be no associated public event occurring.

### **ANALYSIS**

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Raul Peralez will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 3, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.

The Office of the City Clerk will post the item on the City's Website for the March 17, 2021 Rules Committee Agenda and the March 30, 2021 City Council Agenda.
