Analysis

GREEN LIGHT: The Administration can implement this Nominated Idea under its current workplan. Item should be sent to Council to add to Department workplan. Explain how the Idea will be approached.

The procedure for designation of historic districts is outlined in the Municipal Code Section 13.48.120. An area can be nominated by the City Council, Historic Landmarks Commission, Planning Commission or by 60% of the property owners of the area. The initiation of the procedure can be done by Council resolution, after environmental analysis and Title 21 documentation is completed. PBCE staff have begun preliminary work with the Alameda/Schiele community members. Community leaders have completed a community outreach summary, and with the Council-approved Historic Resources Services Consultant Master Agreements, staff have secured services of a historic preservation consultant to complete the tasks for the historic district nomination. The Historic Preservation Officer will oversee the consultant's work and manage the process, including review by the Historic Landmarks Commission.
