**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN JOSE ACCEPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020  
INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE  
AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$950,000 AND  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE  
GRANT AGREEMENT, AND TO EXECUTE ADDITIONAL  
AMENDMENTS AND ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS,  
INCLUDING ONLINE CERTIFICATES AT TIME OF  
REIMBURSEMENT REQUEST, WITHOUT FURTHER CITY  
COUNCIL ACTION**

**WHEREAS**, due to increased access to computers and other technology-related communication devices, the potential for online victimization of children and youth, including unwanted exposure to sexual material, unwanted sexual solicitations, and online harassment, has increased; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San José (“City”) Police Department’s Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force, known as the Silicon Valley Internet Crimes Against Children (“SVICAC”) Task Force, conducts proactive and reactive investigations into computer and technology crimes perpetrated against children; and

**WHEREAS**, the SVICAC Task Force received its first federal grant award in 2003, followed by its initial State of California Office of Emergency Services (“Cal OES”) grant award in 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 23, 2020, the Police Department submitted an application to the Cal OES to continue its work in the area of Internet Crimes Against Children; and

**WHEREAS**, the City was awarded and desires to accept a grant award in the amount of \$950,000 from the Governor’s Office of Emergency Services to be used for funding for a digital forensic analyst and Community Service Officers overtime to help with

community education; forensic software licenses and training, memory and drives for data storage, forensic laptops, utility carts, cell phone booster and cell phone charging locker, industrial cabinet and evidence cage, supplies, services, and software for the Vigilant Parent program; forensic computer, laptop, software licenses, and hardware supplies; investigator cold towers and forensic towers; digital audio system; and one undercover operations vehicle;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The Fiscal Year 2020 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Award in the amount of \$950,000 is hereby accepted.
2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Grant Agreement, additional amendments, and all related documents, including online certificates at time of reimbursement request, without further City Council action.
