RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Approve Earth Day scheduled on April 20th, 2021 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
- 2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
- 3. Place the item on the April 20th, 2021 Council Agenda for action.

BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

In lieu of City Proclamation, Earth Day will be recognized by the City Council on Tuesday, April 20, 2021 and is sponsored by Councilmember Magdalena Carrasco. Earth Day is internationally recognized to demonstrate support for environmental protection and a celebration of biodiversity and has been observed annually on the 22nd of April since 1970. In addition we will be having a District 5 Clean Up Event on April 17th, 2021 to celebrate Earth Day by keeping our communities clean. Everyone will be required to socially distance, wear masks and follow COVID- 1- safety.
