- Previously Council Priority Local Hiring /Local Business/ Apprentice Utilization Program
- On March 28, 2019- Citywide Project Labor Agreement (PLA) executed with Santa Clara/San Benito Counties Building Trades Council
- October 8, 2019- City Council approved Public Works Contracting Program




Analysis

- Data Collection (Dec 2019- Jan 2021)
 - Staff assembled dataset containing ZIP code information on Public Works construction projects
 - Geographic distribution of project work hours, apprentice utilization across trades and project types



Findings


✓ Ratio of 'Local' workers (Santa Clara County) hovers around 30%;





Findings Cont.

✓ Apprentice Utilization Falling





Local Ratios

 Continue to track local worker ratios and local apprenticeship ratios annually with respect to 30% project hour participation goal

 Assess whether a 30% goal represents a healthy equilibrium state for our local context



Apprentice Hours

• Seek opportunities to partner with local preapprentice programs to increase the opportunities for local workers to receive apprenticeships and other work opportunities



Conclusion

- Local hour ratios closely match the percentagegoals of San Francisco and Los Angeles County
- Local apprentice ratios could be improved
- Staff will continue to monitor local worker and apprenticeship ratios
- The City will continue to partner with local apprenticeship organizations to identify opportunities to continue and/or enhance relevant programs.
