Dumpster Days in various neighborhoods listed above were sponsored by Councilmember Foley. These special events were an opportunity for residents to dispose of unwanted junk. The events were free and open to the public, and followed all appropriate local public health rules, including requiring masks and social distancing.

ANALYSIS

Approval by the City Council of the events will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Foley will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 9, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the events. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.
