



- Benches, shelters, and better lighting at stops





The community would like to see:

- Better crosswalks




La Jolla Blvd, Road Diet Before (2007) & After (2018)



Make biking more pleasant and safer by building more protected bike lanes.






Improve Existing Transit Service

Benefits of carshare:


- Access to a vehicle when needed

- Service includes gas, insurance, and emergency assistance






Access and Mobility Plan Timeline

Where we are at and where we are headed


