BACKGROUND

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

In lieu of City Proclamation, National Immigrant Heritage Month by the City Council on Tuesday, May 22nd, 2021 and is sponsored by Councilmember Magdalena Carrasco, June is Immigrant Heritage Month in the United States. Immigrant Heritage Month seeks to celebrate our shared heritage as an immigrant nation and the important contributions to our economy, culture, and common identity by immigrants from all around the world.
