FOR THE EVENT**

## **RECOMMENDATION**

1. Retroactively approve Community Paint Night scheduled on July 30, 2021 as a City Council sponsored Special Event and approve the expenditure of funds.
2. Approve and accept donations from various individuals, businesses or community groups to support the event.
3. Place the item on the August 31, 2021 Council Agenda for action.

## **BACKGROUND**

On February 1, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution 72517 which requires Councilmembers to submit a memorandum to the Rules Committee regarding proposed City Council sponsored Special Events and the proposed use of any funds.

Community Paint Night will be held on July 30, 2021 at Welch Park and sponsored by Councilmember Arenas. This special event is an opportunity for residents to paint, connect and receive a community update. All paint materials, instruction, and light refreshments will be provided. The event is free and open to the public and will follow all appropriate local public health rules, including requiring masks and social distancing.

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## **ANALYSIS**

Approval by the City Council of the event will ensure compliance with the Council's prior direction regarding Council Special Events. In observance of existing fundraising disclosure requirements, Councilmember Arenas will report any cash or in-kind donations received for the event on their Disclosure of Fundraising Report (DFR-1). Approval of this memorandum will enable Council District 8, City departments and the Office of the City Clerk to proceed with the event. Any cash donations received will be processed pursuant to the City's normal financial and budgetary procedures.

The Office of the City Clerk will post the item on the City's Website for the August 25, 2021 Rules Committee Agenda and the August 31, 2021 City Council Agenda.
