Analysis

GREEN LIGHT: The Administration can implement this Nominated Idea under its current workplan. Item should be sent to Council to add to Department workplan. Explain how the Idea will be approached.

San Jose and Santa Clara staff have engaged in negotiations on this topic for several years. VW has most recently refused to negotiate with staff. This Council memo provides slight modification to existing Council Direction in an attempt to help VW move the item forward by providing a regular forum for SJ Council members to meet with VW Board Members to check progress, but not have electeds actually negotiate.

Staff from ESD, CAO, OED and CMO will meet no more than once weekly for 1 hour with VW. A third party facilitator will guide discussions. To enable improved efficiency over prior negotiations, both parties will bring Term Sheets to the first meeting. Negotiations to complete no later than January 2022.
