Get More People Vaccinated

Vaccine Mandate for All Employers with 100+ Employees or Produce Weekly Negative Tests

- Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) developing a rule
- OSHA issuing an Emergency Temporary Standard to implement requirement
- Expected to impact over 80 million workers in the private sector

Also Requiring Vaccination for All Federal Workers and Federal Contractors

Preparing for Boosters

Building Durable and Robust Protection

- Dependent on booster authorization by Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and Center's for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) independent Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices
- Administration planning to offer booster shots as early as week of September 20th (dependent on FDA + CDC authorization)
- Boosters will be free and available across
 80,000 locations
