OF SAN JOSE

RECOMMENDATION

Approve a settlement in the case of *Faz v. City of San Jose* in the amount of \$400,000.00, and authorize the City Attorney to execute a Settlement Agreement.

OUTCOME

The City will pay the sum of \$400,000.00 to settle the lawsuit filed on September 10, 2018 entitled *Glendelia Faz v. City of San Jose, et al.* in the California Superior Court, County of Santa Clara, case number 18CV334698.

BACKGROUND

Plaintiff alleged a dangerous condition of public property against the City after she was struck by a falling Redwood tree branch while sitting at a picnic table at River Glen Park on June 16, 2018. The tree limb was approximately 20 feet long and 4-6 inches wide, and was estimated to have fallen from 40 feet above. As a result of the accident, Plaintiff sustained multiple fractures that ultimately required surgery, resulting in approximately \$232,000 in medical bills.

ANALYSIS

This is a negotiated settlement between the parties to avoid the risks inherent in litigation. The City will pay plaintiffs the sum of \$400,000.00 in full satisfaction and settlement of all claims and plaintiffs will dismiss their entire lawsuit. The proposed agreement will conclude the litigation without further cost, expense, or risk of loss to the City and City employees. The parties will bear their own respective attorneys' fees and litigation costs.
