FY 2019-20 Annual Priorities

- 🏠 Increase and Preserve Affordable Housing
- 🏠 Respond to Homelessness
- 🏠 Strengthen and Stabilize Communities
- 🏠 Promote Fair Housing Choices
- 🏠 **COVID-19 Response**



Increase and Preserve Affordable Housing Opportunities

- 🏠 **472** households received Rental Assistance and Case Management (38% female head of household)
- 🏠 **5** agencies administering rental assistance



Respond to Homelessness

- ▲ **1,586** individuals received street outreach engagement, case management and rapid response
- ▲ **1,326** homeless persons received overnight shelter
- ▲ **41** families assisted with homelessness prevention services



Strengthen and Stabilize Communities – Public Services

- 🏠 **1,152** individuals received legal counseling, education, and outreach services
- 🏠 **198** seniors received direct services
- 🏠 **750** Children served with child care and afterschool services
