2.x Implementation of AB 361 to Allow Teleconferenced Public Meetings to Continue Beyond September 30, 2021

Recommendation:

Adopt a resolution of the Council of the City of San José amending the City's consolidated open government and ethics Resolution No. 77135 to incorporate the Governor's proclaimed COVID state of emergency to allow City legislative bodies to hold public meetings solely by teleconference or otherwise electronically pursuant to AB 361; to modify agenda noticing and document posting; and to incorporate all future Governor's Executive Orders regarding the Brown Act into the City's open government procedures, as deemed appropriate by the City Clerk and City Manager, without further Council action.
