A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE APPROVING THE UPDATED CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION LIMITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SAN JOSE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 12.06.210.D

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2019, the Council of the City of San José ("City") adopted Ordinance 30231, amending Section 12.06.210 of Title 12 of the San José Municipal Code ("SJMC") in response to the movement of the State primary to March of even numbered years; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to SJMC Section 12.06.210.D, the City Clerk is directed to recalculate the campaign contribution limits based on the Consumer Price Index ("CPI") for the San Francisco-Oakland-Hayward area for the month that is at least 280 days before the regularly scheduled primary municipal election and round to the nearest one hundred dollars; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 31, 2021, the 280th day before the June 7, 2022 election, the City Clerk accessed the currently reported CPI in effect; and

**WHEREAS**, the calculations below reflect the change in the campaign contribution limits directed by SJMC Section 12.06.210.D:

Mayor/Post- Election	\$1,000	35.95%	\$1,359.48	\$1,400
