**SUBJECT: UPDATE TO THE AUGUST 2021 – JUNE 2022 NEIGHBORHOOD
SERVICES AND EDUCATION COMMITTEE WORK PLAN**

RECOMMENDATION

Family Friendly Initiative Work Plan Status Report. (Library, Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services, City Manager's Office)

Purpose: Provide a status report on the Family Friendly Initiative Work Plan, including an update on childcare and child well-being efforts resulting from the joint meeting of the NSE Committee and Santa Clara County Children, Seniors, and Families Committee, and progress on Child and Youth Success as directed in the approved June 2021 Budget message.
