A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE SPRING STREET

BETWEEN HEDDING STREET AND ASBURY STREET:

ASBURY STREET BETWEEN WALNUT STREET AND TAYLOR STREET AND IRENE STREET BETWEEN

TAYLOR STREET AND ASBURY STREET

WHEREAS, the City of San Jose ("City") owns and operates the Norman Y. Mineta

San José International Airport ("Airport"); and

WHEREAS, the Guadalupe Gardens area is located on federally regulated land just south

of the Airport in an approach zone, and must be kept clear of inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, in 2002, City Council adopted the Guadalupe Gardens Master Plan ("2002

Master Plan"), which guides street closures and re-use of the Guadalupe Gardens; and

WHEREAS, among other things, the 2002 Master Plan contemplates the (i) closure of

part of Spring Street (from Hedding Street to Asbury Street) and Irene Street between

Taylor Street and Asbury Street for implementation of the Master Plan; and (ii) conversion

of roadway to a recreational path between Hedding and Asbury streets; and

WHEREAS, Spring Street, Asbury Street, and Irene Street in the Guadalupe Gardens

area are currently inhabited with illegal camping and are experiencing serious and

continuing criminal activity and illegal dumping, all of which is facilitated by vehicular and

pedestrian access; and

WHEREAS, under California Vehicle Code Section 21101.4, City Council may

temporarily close streets when serious criminal activity or dumping is a concern; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101.4, the City Council held

a public hearing on September 28, 2021, and the following conditions to exist:

(1) There has been determined to be serious and continual criminal activity and illegal

dumping in the area of the proposed temporary closure, and the City's Police Department

recommends closure;

(2) The subject street is not designated as a through highway or arterial street;

(3) Pedestrian and vehicular traffic contributes to the criminal activity; and

(4) The proposed closure will not substantially adversely affect traffic flow, safety on the

adjacent streets or in the surrounding neighborhoods, the operation of emergency

vehicles, the performance of municipal or public utility services, or the delivery of freight

by commercial vehicles in the area of closure; and

WHEREAS, in order to address these challenges now, City desires to temporarily close

to vehicular and pedestrian access on Spring Street between Hedding Street and Asbury

Street; Asbury Street between Walnut Street and Taylor Street; and Irene Street between

Taylor Street and Asbury Street, actions that support the goals under the 2002 Master

Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SAN JOSE THAT:

The temporary closure to vehicular and pedestrian access of Spring Street between

Hedding Street and Asbury Street; Asbury Street between Walnut Street and Taylor

Street; and Irene Street between Taylor Street and Asbury Street, in the Guadalupe

Gardens is hereby approved for an eighteen (18) month period commencing on

September 28, 2021 and ending on March 27, 2023.
