# Code Enforcement Key Improvements: Management and Oversight

- Implementation of Partner System for Massage Program Inspections
- ► Body Worn Camera Pilot
- Mandatory Supervisor/Inspector Ride-alongs included as part of Supervisor Performance Standards
- Random customer audits, intermittent case review by Supervisors and Division Managers- all programs
- Inspector Rotations and cross training opportunities
- ➤ Information on Reporting Inappropriate Employee Conduct Added to Code Website, Documents, Business Cards, etc.
- Addition of 0.5 FTE Code Overstrength Inspector and 1.0 FTE Code Overstrength Supervisor
