Recommendation 1c. GREEN - Police Department staff will research industry standards and work with City Attorney's Office staff to review and respond to color scheme requirements. The results of this recommendation may create a change in the Municipal Code.
Recommendation 1d. GREEN - Police Department staff will research industry standards and work with City Attorney's Office staff to review and respond to meter requirements. The results of this recommendation may create a change in the Municipal Code.
Recommendation 2. GREEN - Any new requirements imposed on the taxi cab industry will be delayed until such time that staff has had the opportunity to research and review the issues described above. Police and Finance Department staff will provide City Council with an analysis on these items in an Informational Memorandum, in coordination with the Airport and City Attorney's Office.
