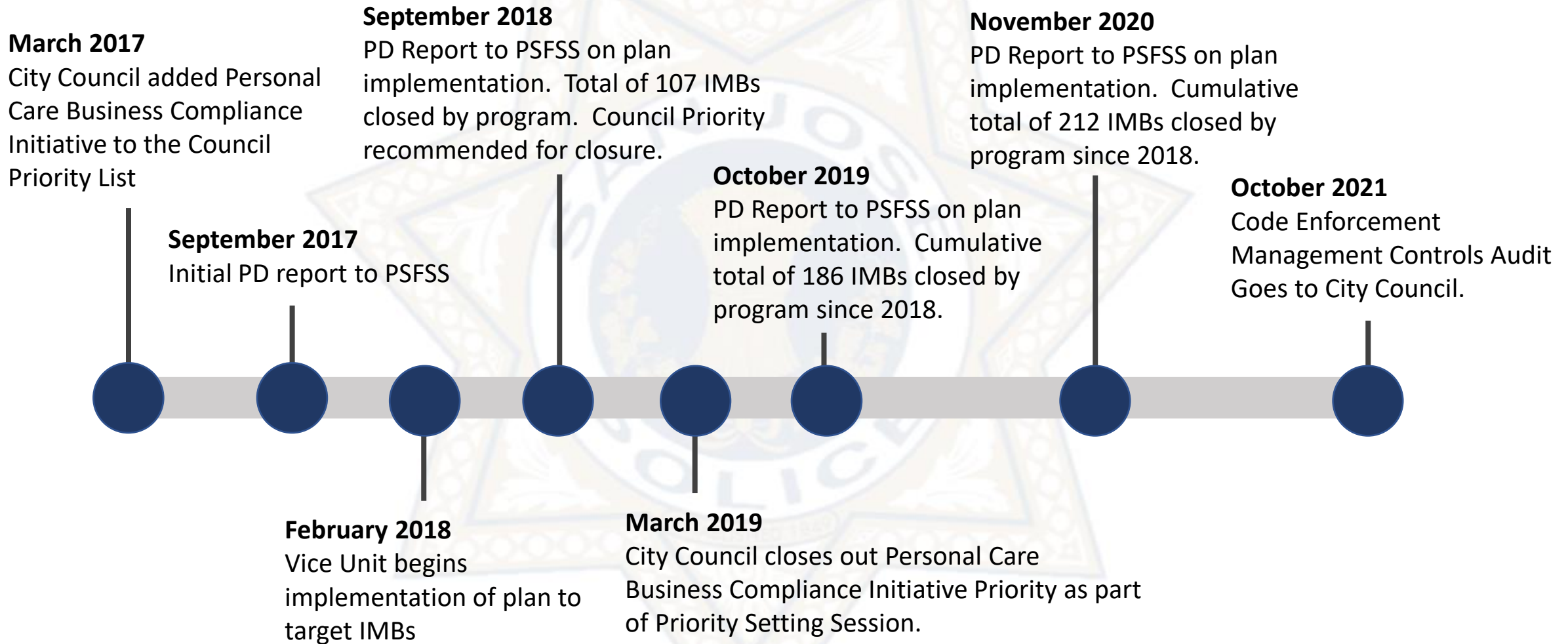

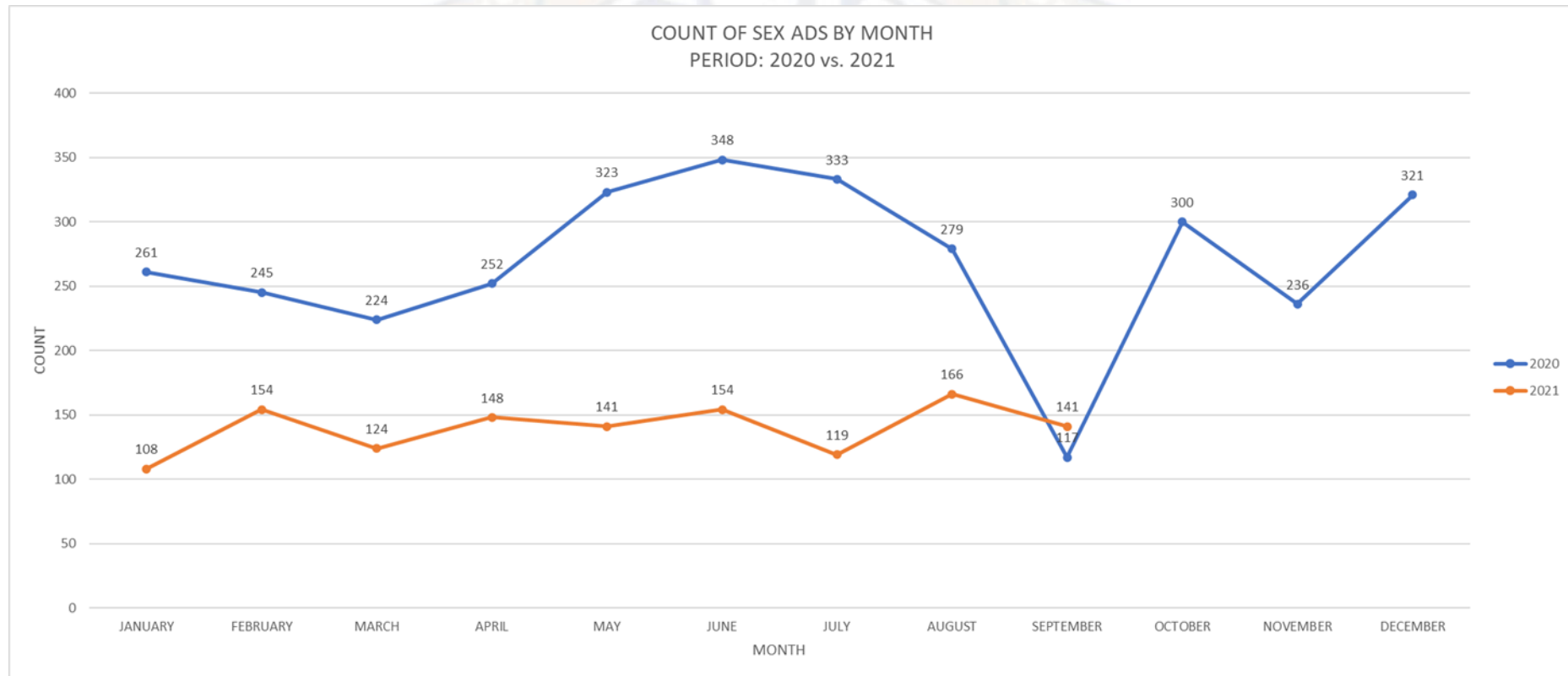
Massage Enforcement Program Timeline
