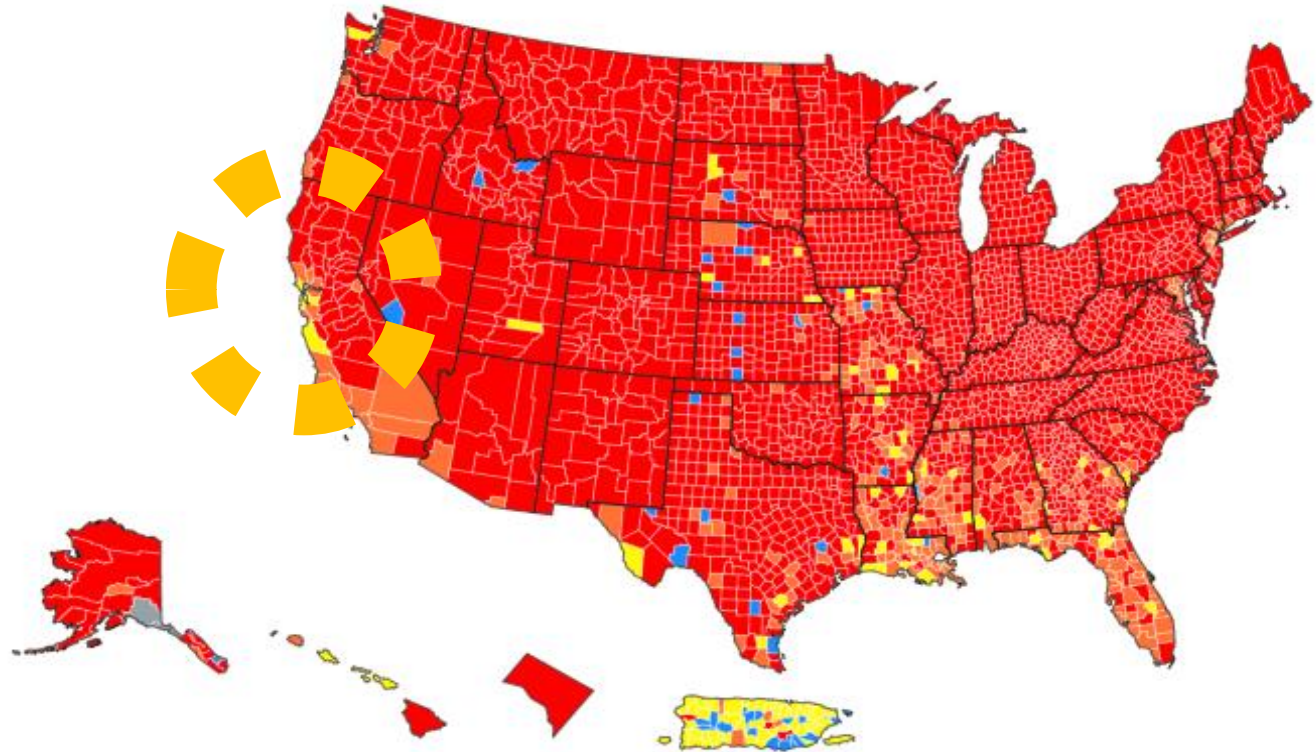
The Delta variant of concern remains highly transmissible and dominant nationally.

There are no variants of interest at this time.

Nine variants are being monitored, none of them are new, but the Delta offshoot AY.4.2 is being watched closely internationally.

The State of California and Santa Clara County are in the CDC substantial (orange) transmission level.

National Level of Community Transmission by County

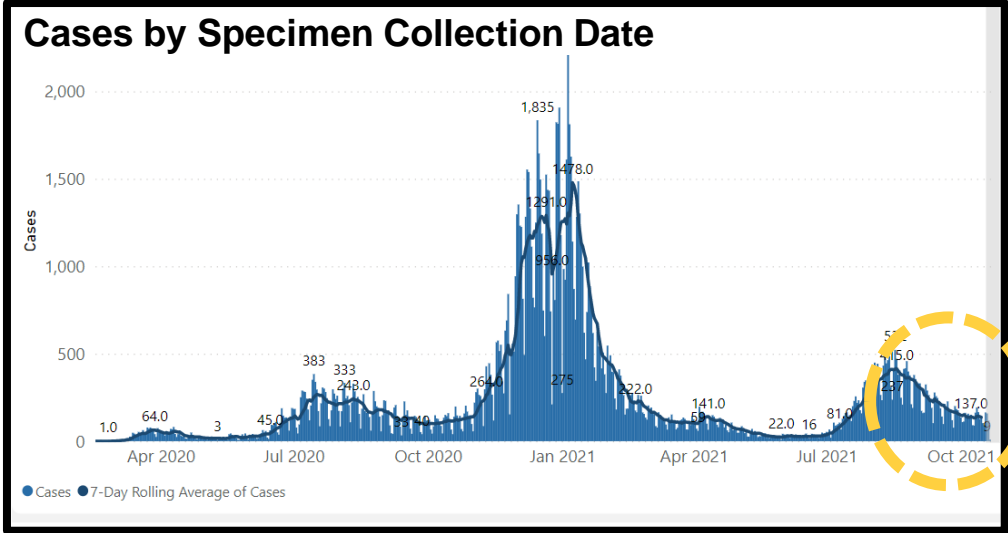

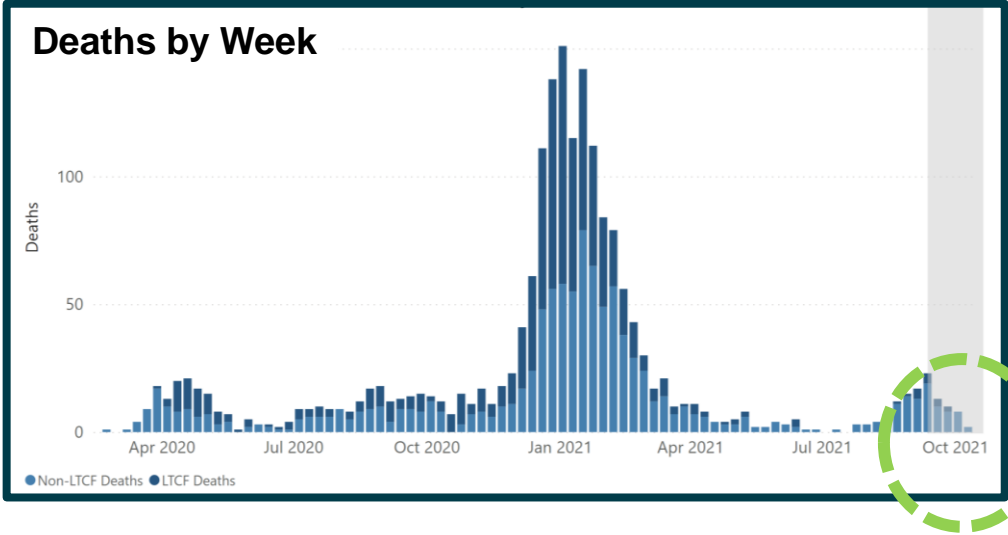


144,719 Cumulative COVID-19 Cases

1,834 Cumulative COVID-19 Deaths

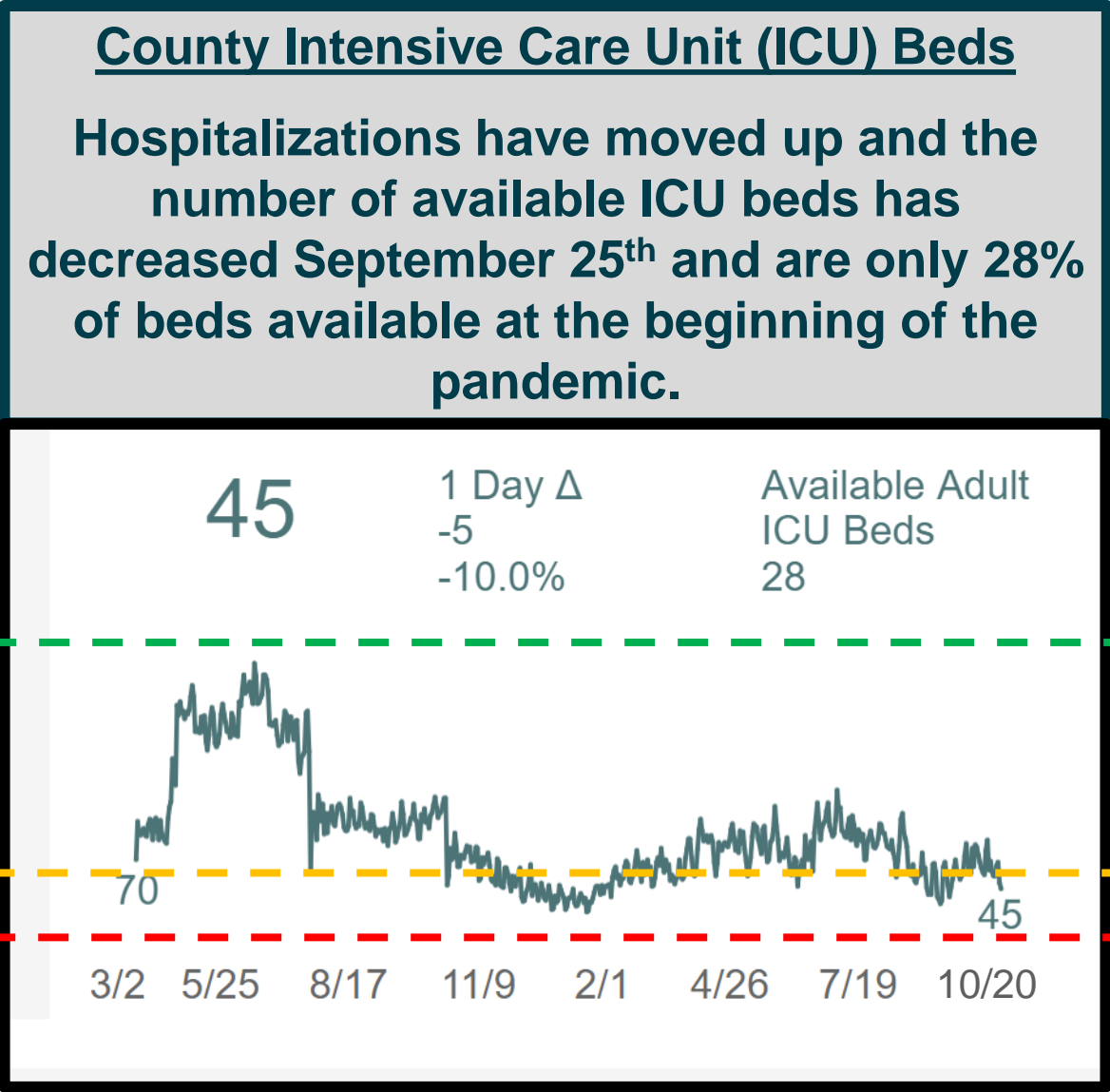

Recent Trends in COVID-19 County Intensive Care Units Beds

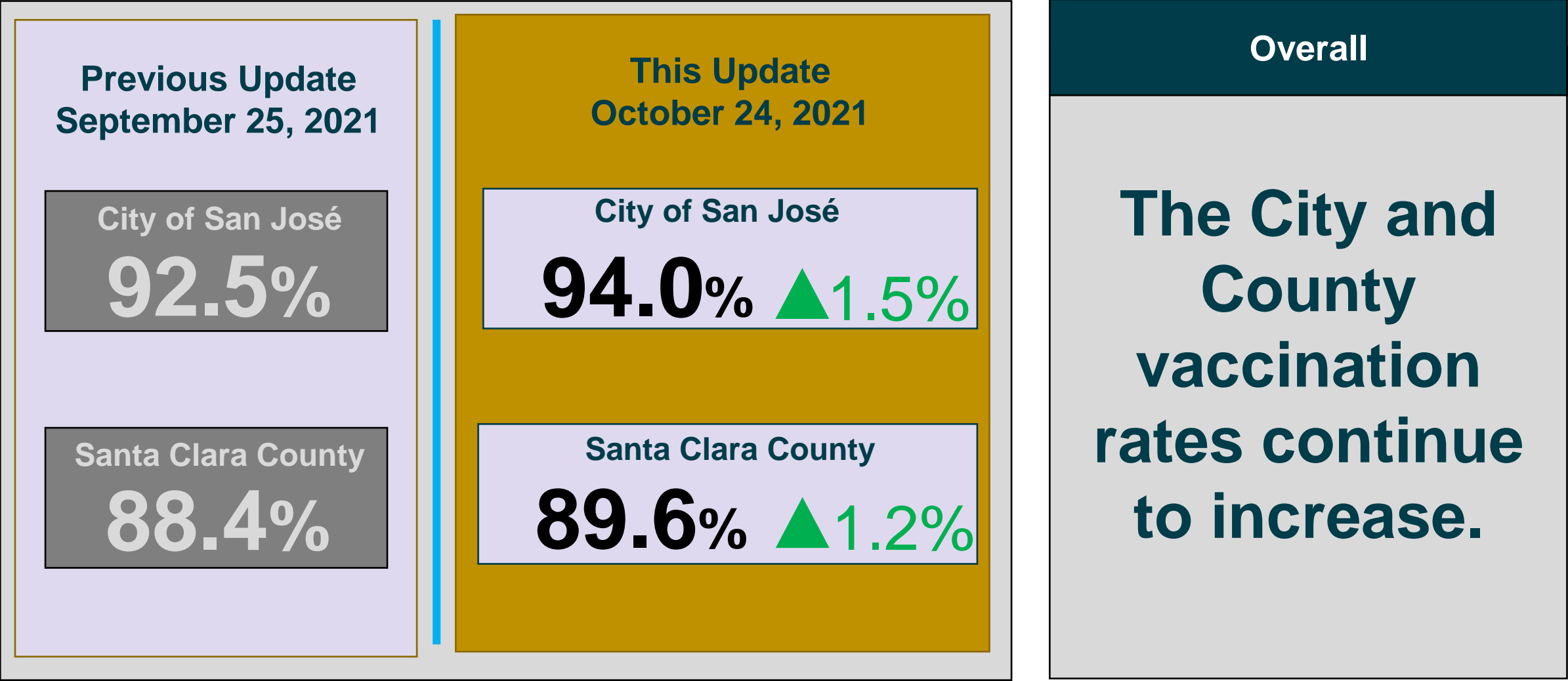


➤ Peak: 239 beds available

City Response Deep Dive | Vaccination Task Force

What Has Changed?

- The City of San José's 93.9% vaccination rate for ages 12+ with at least one dose
- A continued, steady number of participants at vaccination events
- County request for support with communications and outreach to youth ages 5 to 11
- Expansion of approved booster vaccines

What is Driving Change?

- Vaccination mandates
- Expanded eligibility to youth ages 5 to 11 expected in early to mid November
- Data showing waning immunity of vaccines over time

What is New?

- Incorporating rental and housing assistance and resources at vaccination events
- In-home support from San José Fire Department medical personnel

Emerging Plan for Vaccinating Kids Ages 5 to 11

- **Smaller Scale**
 - ~160,000 kids
- **Vaccine Supply**
 - Short-Term (1-3 Weeks): focused
 - Long-Term (3+ Weeks): more broad
- **“Four Doors”**
 - Pediatricians and children's hospitals & health systems
 - Pharmacies
 - Schools
 - Community-based clinics
- **City's Role**
 - City asked to partner with County Public Health Department and Office of Education on communication and outreach efforts
- **Next Steps**
 - County reviewing more detailed plan at Health and Equity Task Force on Friday, October 29th



Emerging Plan for Boosters

- **Additional Booster Vaccines**
 - Moderna and Johnson & Johnson
 - Allowance for mixing and matching
- **Expanded Eligibility**
 - 65 years and older
 - Age 18+ who live in long-term care settings; have underlying medical conditions; who work or live in high risk-settings
- **County Plan**
 - Boosters available at all vaccination sites, including mobile vaccination clinics and retail pharmacies
 - Re-organizing and re-deployment of staff from non-critical areas
 - Improving upon plans from initial vaccination roll out, starting with our most vulnerable, meeting and maximizing needs and efficiencies



City Response | Communications/Outreach

What Has Changed?

We remain focused on communicating to our most vulnerable residents as we pivot to 5 – 11 years old vaccine eligibility.

Data shows Latino/a/x youth, ages 12–17 years old, continue to have the lowest vaccine rate.

What is Driving Change?

- The County of Santa Clara has requested continued support with outreach communications.
- Audience focus: 12-17 years old
- Transition to new audience: 5-11 years old
- Outreach to parents, grandparents, caregivers

What is New?

New tactics to reach focus audience

- **151K postcards** distributed to prioritized areas
- **30K flyers** distributed to 41 schools in San José

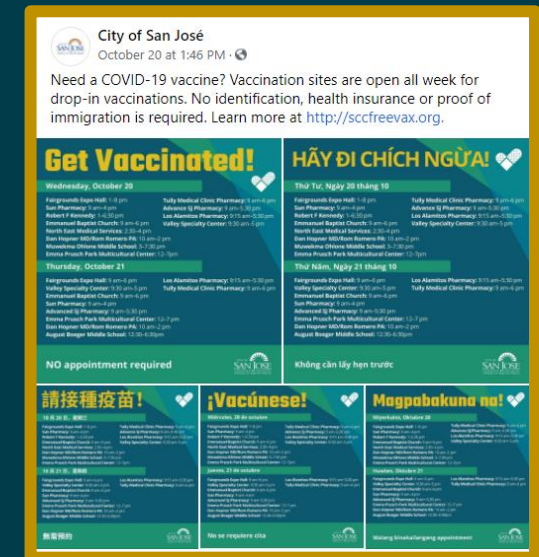
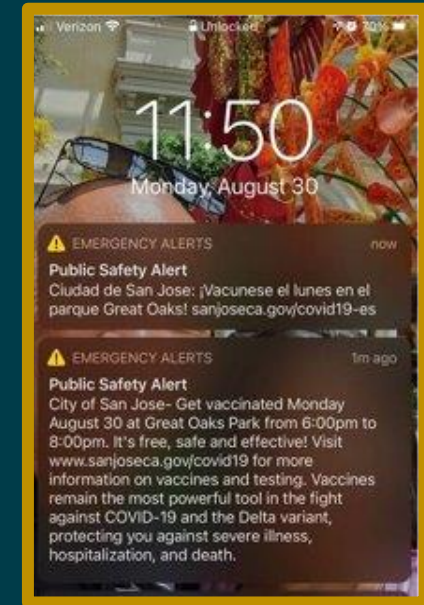

City Response | Communications/Outreach

Continued Communications Support

- **WEA Text Alerts** to focus on marginalized communities
 - **Postcard** mailer to prioritized areas
 - **Flyer** distribution to public schools in San José
- **Mass Media** to reach non-English speaking audiences
- **Social Media** to promote County messaging, vaccine clinics, COVID-19 recovery programs
- **Social Media Influencers** to promote vaccination to key audiences



City Response Deep Dive | Hybrid Work, Facilities, and Resources

New Criteria to Lift Indoor Health Orders on Masking

Criteria to Lift Indoor Masking Order

- **Transmission – Low and Stable**
 - ✓ Must be in the CDCs yellow tier for three continuous weeks
- **Hospitalization – Low and Stable**
 - ✓ Low and stable in the judgment of the local health officer
- **Vaccination – Robust**
 - ✓ 80% of the total population is fully vaccinated; or,
 - ✓ Eight weeks after vaccine authorized for kids ages 5 to 11



County Performance

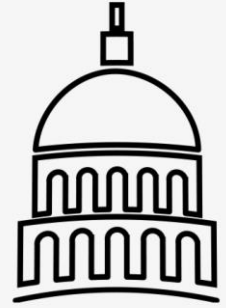
- **Transmission – Low and Stable**
 - ✗ County is in orange tier
- **Hospitalization – Low and Stable**
 - ✗ Hospitalizations are up slightly and ICU bed availability is down
- **Vaccination – Robust**
 - ✗ 73.0% of the total population is fully vaccinated; or,
 - ✗ Vaccine not authorized yet for kids ages 5 to 11



City Response Deep Dive | Advocacy

What Has Changed?

- Expansion of approved booster vaccines
- Governor announced California will mandate student vaccines for COVID-19 once federally approved
 - Uncertain when this will take effect
 - County Office of Education currently expects this will take effect next school year
- Additional movement on implementation of White House Path Out of the Pandemic Action Plan
 - OSHA submitted its Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS) on mandatory vaccination or regular testing for businesses with over 100 employees to the White House OMB Office of Information and Regulatory Affairs
 - The ETS is not yet public
