



- Collect data on apartment amenities








### **Rent Registry New Portals Created**








# Rent Registry Owner Portal Enhancements: Added "No Changes" Button




## Rent Registry Impact: First 30 Day Registrations by Year

#### **Key features for applicants are:**


- Submitting digital application online






### **Doorway Planned Application Metrics to Track**

Key Performance Indicator	Measured
Searches for affordable housing openings via the web portal and smart phone (compared to number of vacancies)	# and %
Applications submitted via the web portal and smart phone (versus paper or in-person)	# and %
Applications submitted via Spanish and Vietnamese languages online and paper application (language equity)	# and %
Vehicle trip miles saved by applicants submitting applications on via the web portal and smart phone (transportation equity)	Average





#### **Purpose of HoLMS**

- Provide reports on aggregate affordable housing data







#### **HoLMS Pain Points Prior to Upgrade**


■ Multiple Residential Development Division teams use the database (Production, Asset Management, etc.)

 likely to be removed from platform in near future






#### **HoLMS Classic: Prior Version**
