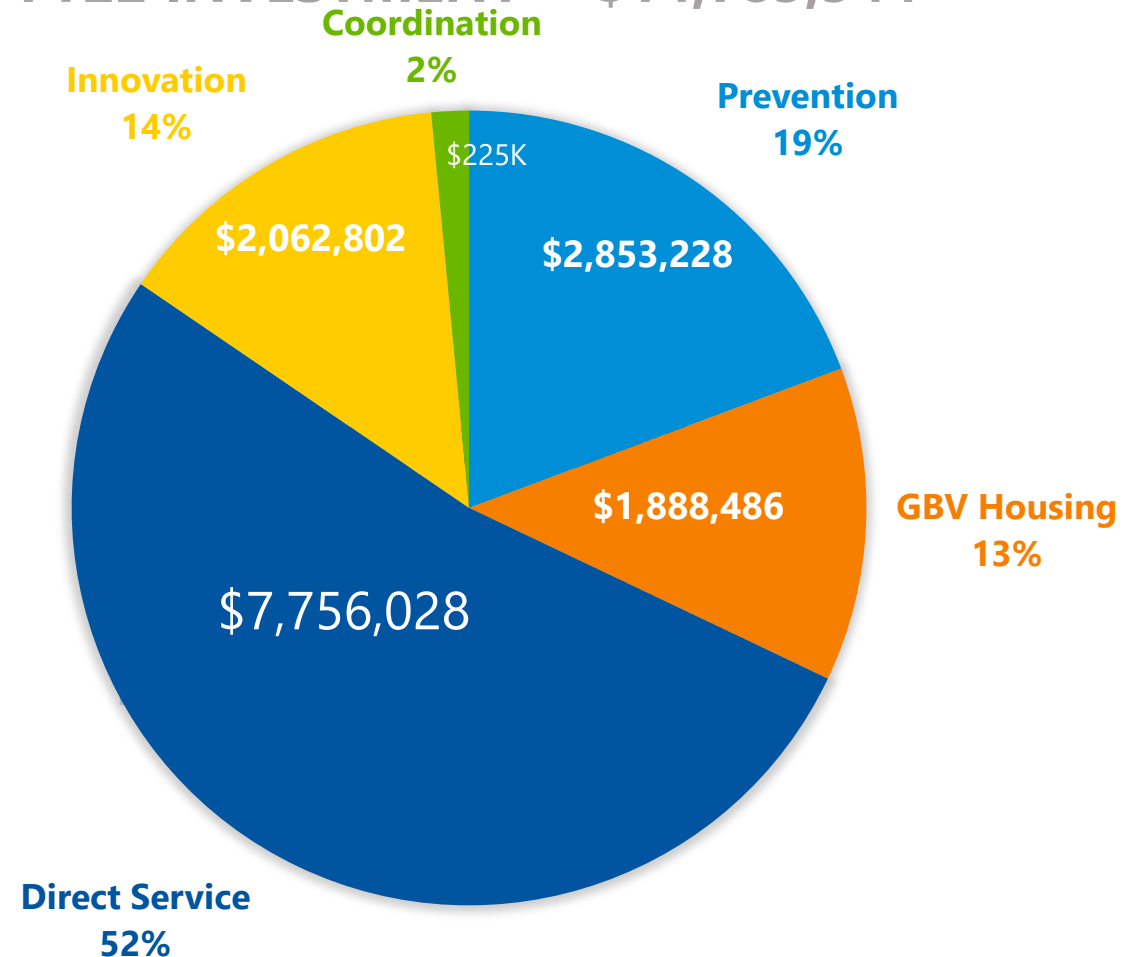

History of Funding

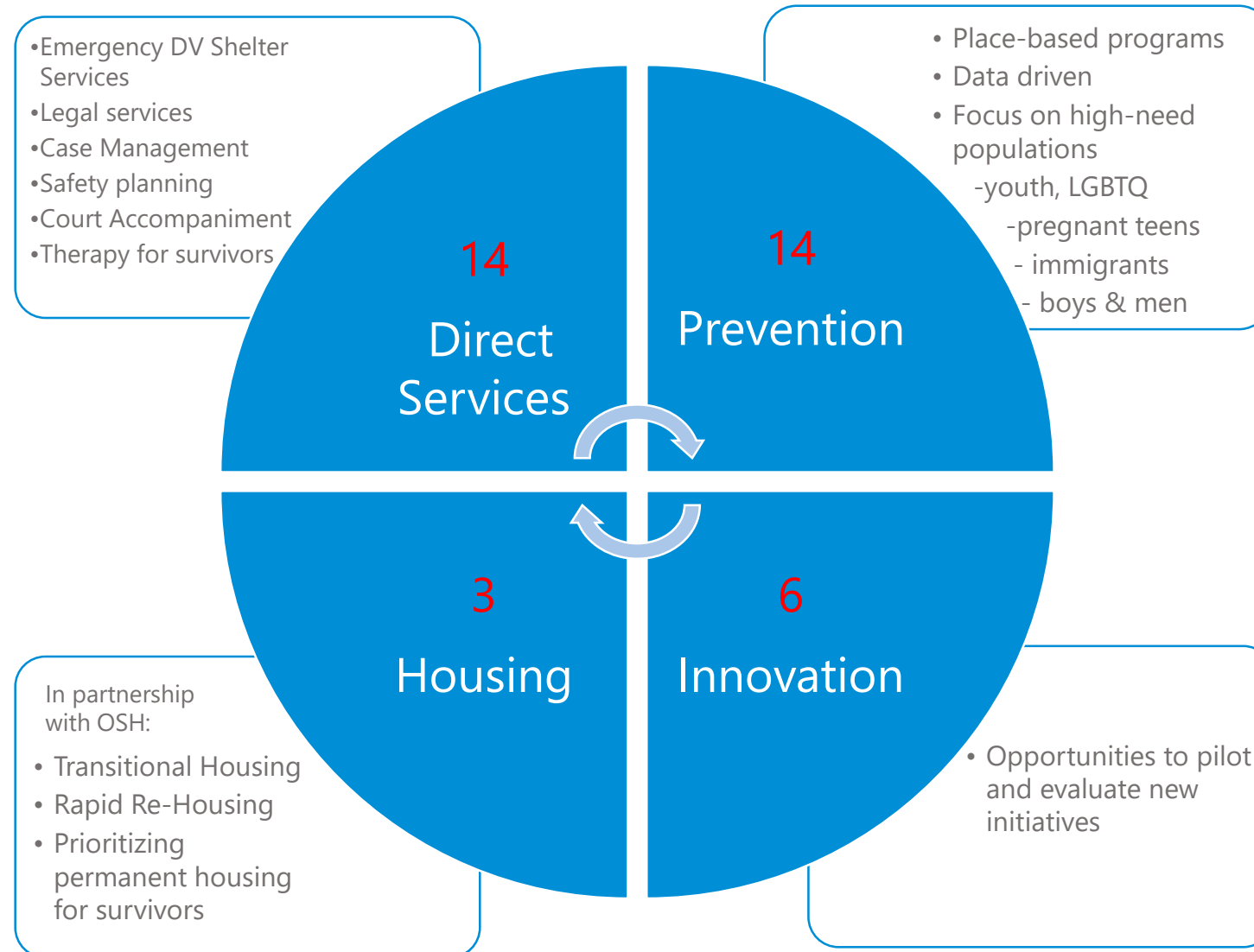
Year	Investment
FY19	\$419,000 - DV \$865,195 - HT
FY20	\$8,272,963
FY21	\$12,617,622
FY22	\$14,785,544

- In FY21, ***17,553 clients** received direct services, and **9,197 clients** participated in prevention programs (*includes some duplicative counts)
- In FY22, the OGBVP increased its funding to administer **37** contracts with **15** community-based organizations.

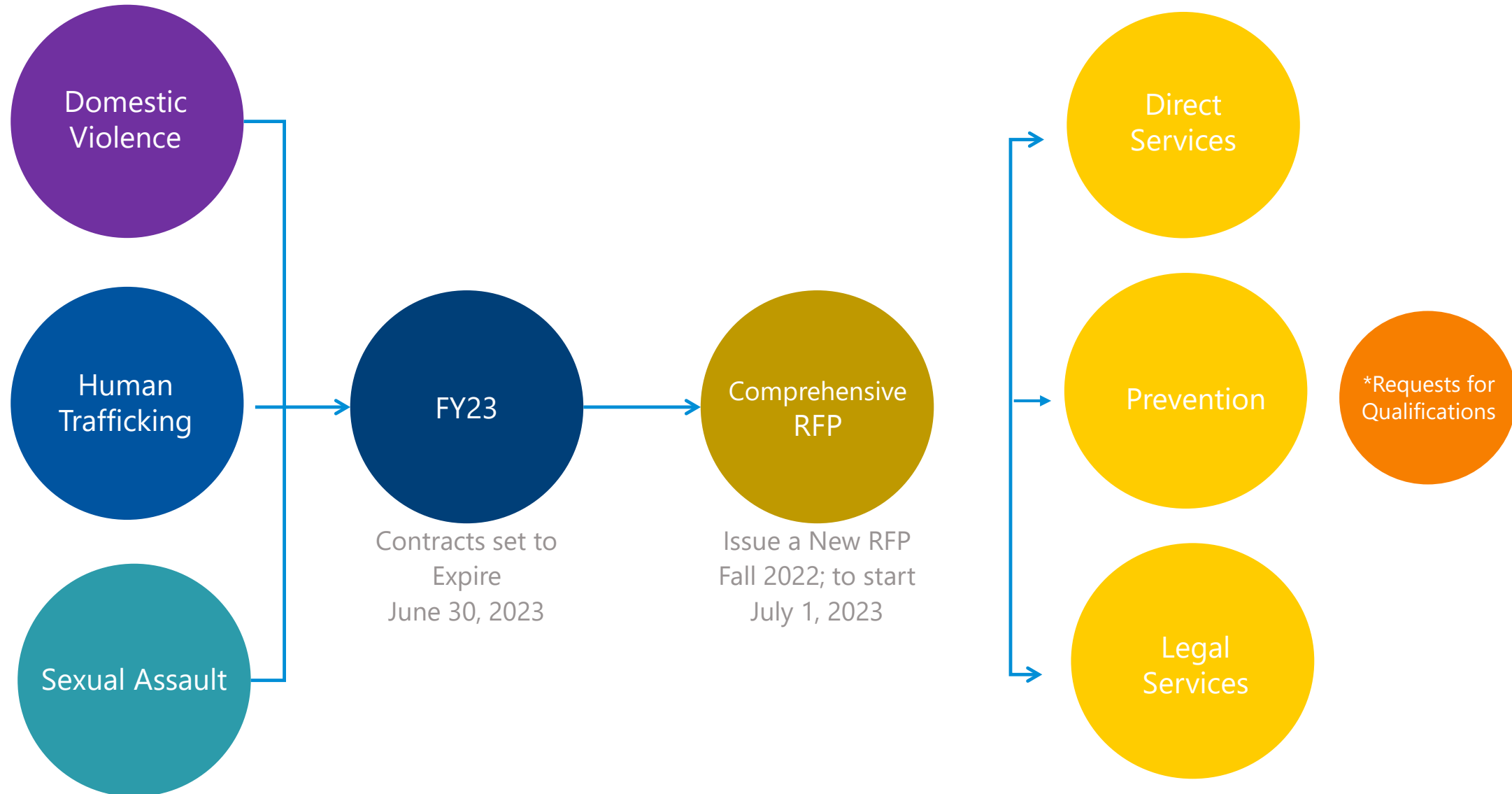
FY22 INVESTMENT = \$14,785,544



Current Structure

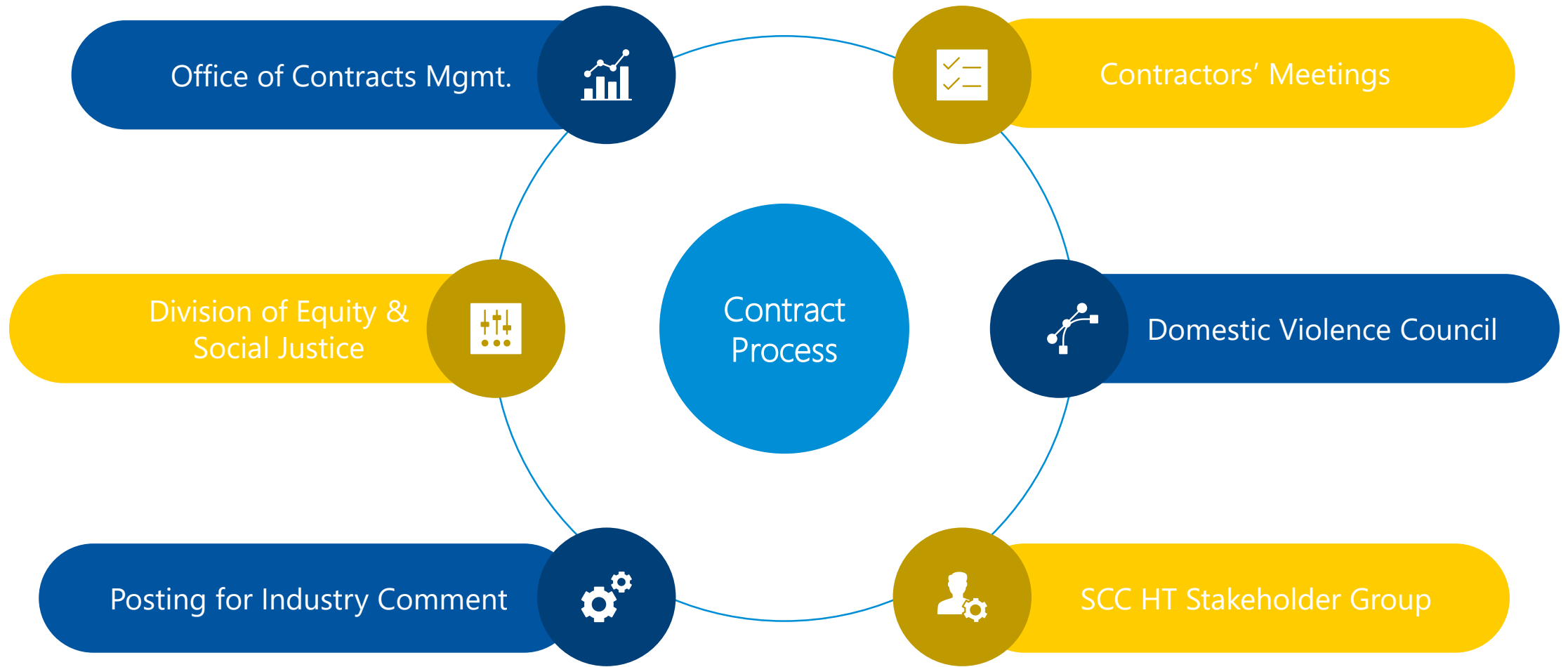
