







# History of Funding

FY20	\$8,272,963
FY21	\$12,617,622
FY22	\$14,785,544


- In FY21, \*17,553 clients received direct services, and 9,197 clients participated in prevention programs (\*includes some duplicative counts)
- In FY22, the OGBVP increased its funding to administer 37 contracts with 15 community-based organizations.



### **Current Structure**


