3.1 23-856 Reallocation of American Rescue Plan Funds.

(a) Approve the reallocation of funding within the American Rescue Plan Fund and the General Fund to ensure completion of community and economic recovery activities previously authorized by the City Council. (b) Adopt the 2022-2023 Appropriation Ordinance amendments in the American Rescue Plan Fund and the General Fund as described in Attachment A to the staff memorandum. CEQA: Not a Project, File No. PP17-008, General Procedure and Policy Making resulting in no changes to the physical environment. (City Manager/Finance)

City Budget Director Jim Shannon provided a brief overview and Finance Director Rick Bruneau, Director in City Manager's Office Sarah Zarate, and Senior Policy Advisor of Holland & Knight Leslie Pollner were available for questions.

<u>Action</u>: Upon motion by Councilmember Dev Davis, seconded by Councilmember Bien Doan, and carried unanimously, (a) the reallocation of funding within the American Rescue Plan Fund and the General Fund was approved and (b) **Appropriation Ordinance No. 30914** was adopted, amending the American Rescue Plan Fund and the General Fund as described in Attachment A to the staff memorandum.
