COMMISSIONER OLIVERIO SECONDED THE MOTION (10-0-1; YOUNG ABSENT).

b. <u>CP18-028 & ER23-108 (Administrative Hearing)</u>: Conditional Use Permit to allow the demolition of an existing approximately 1,200-square-foot convenience store and an approximately 800-square-foot storage building, removal of two billboards, the removal of one ordinance-size tree, and the construction of an approximately 3,183-square-foot convenience store; the early-morning operation of the new convenience store and the existing gas station from 5:30 am Mondays through Fridays; and off-sale of alcohol (beer and wine only) on an approximately 0.43-gross acre gas station site located on the west corner of East Julian Street and North 10th Street (445 & 455 East Julian Street) (Robinson Oil Corp., Owner). ACTION: COMMISSIONER CASEY MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS TO:

- 1. ADOPT A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE ROTTEN ROBBIE #42 PROJECT, FOR WHICH AN INITIAL STUDY WAS PREPARED, AND ADOPTING AN ASSOCIATED MITIGATION MONITORING AND REPORTING PLAN, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA), AS AMENDED;
- 2. ADOPT A RESOLUTION APPROVING, SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS, A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT TO ALLOW THE DEMOLITION OF AN EXISTING APPROXIMATELY 1,200-SQUARE-FOOT CONVENIENCE STORE AND AN APPROXIMATELY 800-SQUARE-FOOT STORAGE BUILDING, REMOVAL OF TWO BILLBOARDS, THE REMOVAL OF ONE ORDINANCE-SIZE TREE, AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN APPROXIMATELY 3,183-SQUARE-FOOT CONVENIENCE STORE; THE EARLY-MORNING OPERATION OF THE NEW CONVENIENCE STORE AND THE EXISTING GAS STATION FROM 5:30 AM FROM MONDAY TO FRIDAY; AND OFF-SALE OF ALCOHOL (BEER AND WINE ONLY) ON AN APPROXIMATELY 0.43-GROSS ACRE GAS STATION SITE.

c. <u>CP23-005 & ER23-020 (Administrative Hearing)</u>: Conditional Use Permit to allow the demolition of the existing Cambrian Station potable water storage reservoir and the removal of 26 trees (20 ordinance-size and six non-ordinance-size with 15 replacement trees), for the construction of two 35-foot-high concrete water storage tanks, two booster pumps, and minor site improvements on an approximately 5.61-gross-acre site located at 3033 South Bascom Avenue (San Jose Water, Owner). Council District: 9. CEQA: Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for Cambrian Tanks Replacement Project, State Clearinghouse No. 2024010140.

- 2. ADOPT A RESOLUTION APPROVING, SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS, A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT TO ALLOW THE DEMOLITION OF THE EXISTING CAMBRIAN STATION POTABLE WATER STORAGE RESERVOIR AND THE REMOVAL OF 26 TREES (20 ORDINANCE-SIZE AND SIX NON-ORDINANCE-SIZE WITH 15 REPLACEMENT TREES), FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TWO 35-FOOT-HIGH CONCRETE WATER STORAGE TANKS, TWO BOOSTER PUMPS, AND MINOR SITE IMPROVEMENTS ON AN APPROXIMATELY 5.61-GROSS-ACRE SITE.
