



**MINUTES OF THE
JOINT MEETING OF THE RULES AND OPEN GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE AND
COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE**

SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA

WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 11, 2019

The Joint Meeting of the Rules and Open Government Committee and Committee of the Whole of the City of San José convened in Regular Session at 2:03 p.m. in Council Chambers.

PRESENT: Mayor Sam Liccardo, Chair; Vice Mayor Chappie Jones, Vice Chair; Councilmember Dev Davis; Councilmember Sylvia Arenas and Councilmember Johnny Khamis, Members.

Public Comment: Blair Beekman expressed concerns on surveillance and the need for low-income housing.

Action: Upon motion by Vice Mayor Chappie Jones, seconded by Councilmember Dev Davis, and carried unanimously, the Committee accepted the December 17, 2019 Final Agenda, including the deferral of Item 2.12(e) to January 14, 2010, and including the final dollar amount of \$600,000 to Item 2.11. Chief of Staff, Office of the City Manager, Lee Wilcox, noted that a second study session will be held on February 13, 2020 to provide progress made and tools available. Director of Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services Angel Rios, Jr. responded to questions.

Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Johnny Khamis, seconded by Vice Mayor Chappie Jones and carried unanimously, the Agenda of the December 13, 2019 Study Session was approved. (5-0.)

3. External Quality Control Review of the Office of the City Auditor for the Period July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2019 (City Auditor)

City Auditor Joe Rois provided a brief overview.

Action: Upon motion by Vice Mayor Chappie Jones, seconded by Councilmember Dev Davis and carried unanimously, the External Quality Control Review of the Office of the City Auditor for the Period July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2019 was accepted. (5-0.)

4. Annual Merit Increases and Additional Executive Leave for Council Employees (Mayor)

Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Johnny Khamis, seconded by Vice Mayor Chappie Jones and carried unanimously, Annual Merit Increases and Additional Executive Leave for Council Employees was placed on the December 17, 2019 Council Meeting Agenda for Council discussion and action: To adopt a resolution approving a 2.5% merit increase for the City Manager, City Attorney, Independent Police Auditor, City Clerk and City Auditor effective July 1, 2019 and granting an additional forty (40) hours of executive leave to each of these Council Appointees for the payroll calendar year 2020. (5-0.)

5. City Council Direction on Cost of Development Report Workload Assessment (Economic Development)

Deputy City Manager/Director of Economic Development Kim Walesh and Deputy Director Chris Burton offered a workload assessment and additional analysis of the impact of development standards and zoning restrictions in the development review process on the cost of residential development, as requested at the November 6, 2019 meeting of the Rules and Open Government Committee.

Action: Upon motion by Councilmember Johnny Khamis, seconded by Councilmember Dev Davis and carried unanimously, the report was accepted. (5-0.)


