#### 3.1. <u>Executive Director (Morrisey)</u>

a. Accept Verbal Reports on Arena Authority Oversight

• <u>SAP Center at San Jose.</u> Executive Director Morrisey restated some of the issues regarding transit and property development in the area adjacent to the Center.

- <u>Solar4America Ice at San Jose</u>. The City Council will be taking action on the proposed expansion of Solar4America Ice at San Jose at the December 10 City Council meeting. It was also reported that funding for the Authority's oversight of Solar4America Ice at San Jose is proposed at \$100,000 for FY 2020-21.
- <u>Excite Ballpark Home of the San Jose Giants.</u> The update will be reported under the stadium committee's report.

- <u>VTA/BART Downtown/Diridon Community Working Group.</u> The Community Working Group convened in November to continue the discussion of the side-by-side track design with a center platform for rider ingress and egress. The VTA's current schedule for testing the new transit system is targeting 2028.
- <u>Emergency Resources Network</u>. The network continues to move forward with a comprehensive analysis of physical barriers of a number of City-owned facilities.
- <u>South Campus Operations Team</u>. The team met with a representative from the City's Homeless Response Team to provide contact information when SCOT members or patrons come in contact with someone who is currently homeless.
