### 1. Update on Environmental Services Department Position Reallocation Requests (H.R.)

Director of Employee Relations/Human Resources, Jennifer Schembri provided a response to the reallocation appeal classification study and responded to questions from the Commission. She indicated that in response to the reallocation appeals and per the request of the Commissioners, the Human Resources Department conducted a classification and compensation study for the Environmental Services Program Manager classification. The outcome of the study is to create a higher level classification, Senior Environmental Services Program Manager.

The current Environmental Services Program Manager classification remains; however, the Senior Environmental Services Program Manager classification has higher level duties and significant impact on City-wide organizational priorities.

Director of Employee Relations/Human Resources, Jennifer Schembri further noted that, in coordination with the Environmental Services Department, the three pending/denied reallocations will be reallocated to the newly created classification of Senior ESPM. All other positions will remain in the ESPM classification. The April 2020 Civil Service Commission is targeted for filing of the new classification.
