1. <u>Call to Order/Roll Call/Introductions</u>. The Arena Authority convened the Annual Meeting of the Board of Directors at 4:02 pm.

- a. <u>Update on Activities at SAP Center at San Jose and Solar4America Ice at San Jose</u>. Jon Gustafson, Vice-President of Sharks Sports & Entertainment, updated the Board on the SAP Center at San Jose capital improvement projects (arena floor and south door escalators) and the progress of the Solar4America Ice at San Jose expansion project.
- b. <u>Update on Activities for the San Jose Diridon Station Area Plan</u>. Bill Ekern, City of San Jose, provided an update on the Diridon Station Area Plan.
- c. <u>Review and Approve October 28, 2020 Regular Board Meeting Minutes</u>. Approved with 8 approvals, 2 abstentions (Sutherland and Weekes), . 1st: Kennett, 2nd: Buchholz.

 - <u>SAP Center at San Jose</u>. Letters were sent to the City's Department of Planning, Building and Code Enforcement for the Diridon Station Arena Plan and the Downtown West Mixed-Use Plan (Google project). - <u>Solar4America Ice at San Jose (Verbal)</u>. Due to the coronavirus pandemic, ice programs have been suspended.

b. <u>Accept Verbal Reports on Arena Authority Administrative Items</u>

- VTA/BART Downtown/Diridon Community Working Group. A Framework for Completions was shared with the Board. Executive Director Morrisey advised VTA staff to engage Google in future CWG meetings.
- <u>Emergency Resources Network</u>. Team San Jose has been very active during the pandemic, including housing and feeding 250 people on-site and providing meals for 15,000 people per week. With virus cases surging, the ERN's leadership team discussed measures to take in the event hospitals run out of on-site space.
- <u>South Campus Operations Team</u>. Construction in the south campus area includes the expansion of Solar4America Ice at San Jose, building a number of new sports facilities and a 1,500 space parking garage at San Jose State University and the construction of a new San Jose Fire Training Center just south of Excite Ballpark Home of the San Jose Giants.
- <u>City of San Jose Emergency Resources Council</u>. No report.
