A. Discussion and possible action on report from Ad Hoc Committee for Complaint Intake Process. (Chair Adrian Gonzales/City Attorney)

<u>Discussion</u>: Sr. Deputy City Attorney Mark Vanni did not have any update. Board Member Louis Silver asked how frequently the Board asks the Mayor's Office for an update, Sr. Deputy City Attorney Mark Vanni stated that the Mayor's Office has recently been informed the need to do a biennial review.

B. Discussion and possible action on biennial review of San Jose Municipal Code Title 12, City Council Resolution 78390 and other administrative policies. Suggested Revisions to the SJMC Title 12 and Resolution 78390 (City Clerk)

<u>Discussion</u>: Chair Adrian Gonzales stated that he recommends establishing policies and procedures for managing complaints for appeals to records that were denied.

C. Discussion of City Council Referral from July 28, 2020: proposed campaign finance and conflict of interest reforms, board and commission reforms, and lobbyist and contractor restrictions (Ad Hoc Status Update Report; Status update on the <u>audit</u> being conducted by <u>Hanson Bridgett</u>). <u>Discussion</u>: Chair Adrian Gonzales stated that Hanson Bridgett sent a spreadsheet of the City's roster of registered lobbyists and he would analyze and present the results in the next meeting. Sr. Deputy City Attorney Mark Vanni opined that it looks thorough and complete, he also stated that the budget has for this project has exceeded by \$10,000.00. Board Member Joe Lopez asked if this excess is on top of the contractual obligation; Sr. Deputy City Attorney Mark Vanni stated that these are for staff hours worked and entitled to be compensated.

D. Status update on ongoing work from the Campaign Finance Study Session from April 20, 2021. (City Clerk/City Attorney)

<u>Discussion</u>: Sr. Deputy City Attorney stated that the goal is to present to City Council sometime in the end of October or early November but prior to that is to present to

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the Board on the next meeting regarding campaign disclaimers. Research is still ongoing for public financing, foreign influence corporations.

E. Status update on collaboration with Charter Review Commission. (Chair Adrian Gonzales)

<u>Discussion</u>: Sr. Deputy City Attorney stated that the Charter Review Commission voted to advance the recommendation to have the Mayoral election changed to the Presidential cycle. Other items such as Rank Choice Voting, elevating the Board to a Charter Commission, and increasing council districts would be discussed at a later meeting.

<u>Discussion</u>: Chair Adrian Gonzales had a check-in with Ryan; he stated that the group's priorities are to have a portal for the independent expenditure committees and prepare for the 2022 elections.
