### **Amendment to Title 3 of the San José Municipal Code Amending the Police and Fire Department Retirement Plan to Allow for Continuation of Survivorship Benefits for Active Fire Members Killed in the Line of Duty.**

Approve an ordinance amending Section 3.36.1290 of Chapter 3.36 of Title 3 of the San José Municipal Code to allow spouses and domestic partners of active Fire members killed in the line of duty to continue their survivorship benefits in the event that they remarry or re-establish a domestic partnership.
