Accept the report on Parking/Transportation Demand Management (TDM) ordinance update and direct the administration to develop, for Council Consideration, the following (Title 20) Zoning Code Amendments:

- (a) Removal of mandatory minimum off-street parking requirements (except in areas where the City has defined contractual agreements regarding parking) and implements, a market-based parking approach; and (b) Provisions to the City's Transportation Demand Management (TDM) requirements for pay development
- (b) Revisions to the City's Transportation Demand Management (TDM) requirements for new developments (except for small projects); and
- (c) TDM program for ongoing monitoring and compliance of new developments citywide.
