(a) Adopt resolutions approving the Operating Budget for 2023-2024 for the City of San José, the Capital Budget for 2023-2024 for the City of San José, and the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for 2024-2028 for the City of San José as revised by the Mayor's Budget Message and directing the City Manager to prepare final documents for adoption.

(b) Adopt a resolution establishing the Schedule of Fees and Charges for 2023-2024.

(c) Approve an uncodified ordinance establishing the Schedule of Fees and Charges for 2023-2024 specified in the resolution.
