### **Actions Related to the Measure T Status Report on the Workplan and Implementation Updates.**

- (a) Accept the status report on the workplan and implementation updates for projects included in approved 2018 Measure T Bond measure.
- (b) Accept the Measure T Community Oversight Committee's annual report, as identified in Attachment A to the staff memorandum, on the Measure T - The Disaster Preparedness, Public Safety and Infrastructure General Obligation Bond Program proceeds and allocations for Fiscal Year 2020-2021.
- (c) Approve the proposed site at the intersection of Capitol Expressway and Tuers Road for the construction of new Fire Station 36.
- (d) Adopt the following 2021-2022 Appropriation Ordinance amendments in the Public Safety and Infrastructure Bond Fund:
  - (1) Increase the Measure T - Police Headquarters Infrastructure Upgrades appropriation to the Public Works Department by \$250,000; and
  - (2) Decrease the Measure T - Program Reserve (Public Safety) appropriation by \$250,000.
- (e) Provide staff direction on a policy decision in regards to funding of projects identified in Tables 2 and 4 of the Public Safety Program Reserve section of the report.
- (f) Approve the proposed City Land South of Phelan site as a project to be funded by the Clean Water Program. CEQA: Not a Project, File No. PP17-009, Staff Reports, Assessments, Annual Reports, and Informational Memos that involve no approvals of any City action. (Public Works/City Manager)
