City Initiatives Roadmap - Clean Energy Resilience: Agreements with Middle River Power and Sentinel Energy Center for Resource Adequacy and Dispatchable Energy.

Adopt a resolution authorizing the Director of Community Energy to negotiate and execute an agreement with: (a) Middle River Power, or its affiliate MRP Pacifica Marketing LLC, using the Edison Electric Institute Agreement with modifications, as appropriate, to buy Resource Adequacy and Dispatchable Energy products from a natural gas plant and associated battery, in an amount not to exceed \$15,800,000 annually and \$190,000,000 in aggregate during Calendar Years 2024 through 2036, to be paid solely from the San José Clean Energy Operating Fund and subject to the annual appropriation of funds; and

(b) Sentinel Energy Center, LLC, using the Edison Electric Institute Agreement with modifications, as appropriate, to buy Resource Adequacy and Dispatchable Energy products from a natural gas plant that will be retrofitted to have the capability to burn a natural gas and green hydrogen blended fuel to generate the products under the agreement, in an amount not to exceed \$18,600,000 annually and \$186,000,000 in aggregate during Calendar Years 2023 through 2033, to be paid solely from the San José Clean Energy Operating Fund and subject to the annual appropriation of funds.
